Resident and student posters will be eligible for awards in two separate categories. 1) Resident and 2) Medical Student. To be eligible for judging and awards, the first author must be a psychiatric resident or medical student.

Guidelines

The body of the abstract should be organized as indicated below. Each section will have an 800 character limit.

- 1. Introduction background or purpose of the research
- 2. Methods- description of the study
- 3. Results summary of the results and conclusions reached
- 4. Discussion relevance of the study

Fees and Expenses

Everyone presenting a Poster or Abstract must complete a registration form and pay the appropriate fees associated with registration. Registration for the Annual Meeting will open soon.

Equipment

Presenters must bring a mounted 36" H x 48" W poster. Easels will be provided. (Print shops can mount posters to foam board, etc. for you.) Each board will be identified by a number assigned to the accepted poster.
